



National Veteran Vehicle Rally October 23rd – 28th 2022 Busselton WA

Welcome to the latest newsletter for the 2022 National Veteran Vehicle Rally to be held in Busselton WA between the 23rd & 28th October 2022. It has been a while since the last newsletter, primarily because we have just returned from a bit of a break at the Narrandera 1 & 2 Cylinder Rally.

Since our return, we have been getting stuck into arrangements for Busselton. We are now in a position to advise the following timetable & milestones leading up to the rally.

1. Registration is open now. A link for registration is at the bottom of this newsletter.
Registration will require payment of the rally entry fee and the online registration process includes provision for online payments. Registration will remain open from now until the cut off at the end of July.
2. Meal forms will follow in mid August. Payment for meals will also be completed online. An email with a link to the meals form will be sent to entrants in mid August.
The meal forms will need to be completed and payment made by 15 September.
3. October.....Head for Busselton where we are looking forward to seeing you all.

Throughout the week, we will have a mix of BYO and catered morning teas.

Accordingly, you will need to bring a thermos, cups and supplies for making your own morning tea.

Some morning tea and lunch destinations will only have limited seating so we encourage, if possible, all entrants bring folding chairs if they can fit them in their car.

The Tuesday course will be a bit of a challenge as it is quite long, but the destination is worth the trip. Morning and afternoon tea stops are located in Capel which is midway along the route. At Rally HQ, we will have a Swaggie Board. If you feel your car is going to struggle to manage 160km, please feel free to put your names on the Swaggie board. On the other hand, if you have a capable car & spare seat/s, please consider putting your contact details up or contacting people directly.

The longest run between fuel stops is 90km but the backup vehicles can carry spare fuel by arrangement.

The official welcome will be at 4pm.

Monday 24 October – Busselton – Peppermint Grove Beach

Today's run is a short one of approx 75km over flat roads through the Tuart forests east of Busselton. We will be having morning tea at the rally HQ prior to starting the run. Lunch will be a catered picnic box at the destination

Tuesday 25 October – Dardanup Heritage Park

Today is the longest run – a total of 160km. It will be over flat back roads. Morning tea will be DIY today, either bring your own, or purchase from the cafes & bakeries in the main street of Capel. Lunch will be at the Café attached to the Dardanup Heritage Park. Afternoon tea can also be purchased in Capel on the way back. Fuel is available in Capel if required.

Wednesday 26 October – Free Day with display in Busselton

Today we will be mounting a static display of our vehicles at Signal Park just west of the jetty. The display will run from 10am until 4pm and the vehicles will be secured by volunteer local club members. This will give entrants a free day, there are many things to do in the area, your rally bag contains information on local attractions.

Wednesday Evening will be a social BBQ at the Rally HQ. There will be entertainment provided

Thursday 27 October – Hippo Lake

Today we will be travelling to Vasse primary school where we will be parked on the oval for 1 hour while class groups come to see the cars. Entrants will need to bring your own morning tea to have while at the school. It would be great to see lots of period costumes today as it will add greatly to the student's experience. After leaving the school, we will be following back roads to a local Restaurant café for a catered lunch. The total travelled will be 65km.

Friday 28 October

The run today will take us via back roads to the Willyabrup Hall for a bring your own morning tea. After morning tea there will be a further drive, going to the Sharp's Motor Museum for a catered picnic lunch. Then there is a short run back to town. The total distance will be 93km today.

The Final Dinner will be in the Undalup room at the City of Busselton Civic Centre (200m up the road towards town from Rally HQ) from 6pm for 6.30pm dinner.
