




6. You can now log in using your email and the new password. If you wish, you may immediately "Change Password" (to one you can remember!) using the blue "Change Password" in the top right hand corner.



And you will get a screen like this.





7. As a first time user you will get this message and you will need to accept the terms and conditions to proceed.




8. Click on your name in the top right hand corner ("New Member" in this example) and you will see the following






Member details




